

# Creative Writing

Participants in this creative writing workshop will write several short stories and develop various forms of writing each class. Through a range of engaging exercises, writers are taught strategies that help establish writing voice. There's no pressure to work on a specific project – the idea is to explore—play with different ideas, spark characters from your imagination and bring them to life, gain confidence in your writing and storytelling, and experiment with both fiction and nonfiction. Creative writing is one of the most fulfilling ways to express yourself, and you're never too young or too old to give it a try. Participants will write and receive feedback on all writing exercises and assignments. This workshop also offers instruction on revision and will help you gain insight from your writing peers. Upon completion of the workshop you will achieve a clearer understanding of tone, voice, and word choice.
